

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

Thank you for your faithful support of me and the ministry at BLC. While I'm still in the grieving process after my wife Jenny's death on February 4th, I seek to live out my calling as I'm acutely aware of the brevity of life. Perhaps many of you also have that acute awareness.

Every week most of us are aware of family or friends who have recently died. We only have limited time and limited resources to do what God would have us do. As someone texted me this morning we live in "such a broken world." Loneliness is epidemic. Fortunately, we have a remedy for that epidemic. It doesn't require a vaccination or medicine. It's provided by the Good News of God's love and forgiveness that we have in Jesus Christ. It's realized through the fellowship of God in Jesus Christ and in His people.

Invite people to church. Participate in the fellowship of the Body of Christ. God has put us here on earth and given us His blessing that we might truly bless others—not with superficialities, but with the eternal fellowship of the Creator and Redeemer of the universe. The Bible is not so much a book of advice, but the Good News of a crucified and resurrected Jesus that gives us victory over Death, the Devil and our sinful flesh. That is what separates Christianity from other religions. What distinguishes the Christian Faith is the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. That Good News is what helps us to walk in Newness of Life.

Don't let that Good News pass you by; don't ever lose it. It is a game changer. It sets you free to be the person God intended you to be.

May the Peace, the Joy, and the Power of the Resurrected Christ be the most important thing in your life. If you'd like to talk about that more, please let me know.


RightNow Media Study of the Month:
